Prayer And The Laying-On Of Hands

Come To Jesus

Please remember as you come for this ministry of prayer that it is to Jesus you come. Others will lay their hands upon you and pray, but it is Jesus who heals. He said '*without Me you can do nothing*'.

Laying-On Of Hands

We believe that when we pray with the laying-on of hands we simply bring people to Jesus and ask Him to touch them and heal them.

Come Expectantly

When we come to receive prayer we should come expectantly. Jesus said, '*If you ask for anything in My name, I will give it to you*'. So come with confidence, taking Jesus at His word.

Be Open

Come relaxed and open to receive the healing that God wishes to give you. There is no need to be shy or nervous as you come for prayer. You can be at peace in the presence of Jesus.

Let go

Try to let go of anything that may be burdening you—fears, worries, anxieties, resentment, anger, jealousy. In the silence before the service starts yield any of these burdens into God's hands.

The Best Preparation

Jesus healed many people who were certainly not His followers at that time. He can do so today. But we believe that anyone who

has made that full commitment of their lives to Jesus places themselves in a better position to receive healing.

Be Specific

Be specific when you come for prayer. Do not beat about the bush. Ask Jesus for the type of healing that you want.

Picture Jesus

When we lay our hands upon you picture Jesus coming and laying His hands on top of ours and letting His mighty power flow into every part of you.

Keep Your Eyes On Jesus

Keep your eyes on Jesus during the prayer, not on the sickness. Do not take your eyes off Him.

Play your Part

As you receive prayer, quietly, gently give thanks into yourself by faith that the power of God is coming into you.

Give Thanks

After you receive prayer, and in the days to come, give thanks to God that He has touched you. It helps, if you exercise your faith in this way, to hold on to the healing that you have received and to allow it to grow.

Scriptural Authority

Remember that in coming to a service of divine healing we are just being obedient to the teaching of Scripture - *'If any of you are sick, send for the elders of the Church to pray over you and anoint you with oil. If you do that you will be made well, for the prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective'*.
